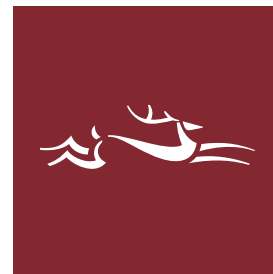

I would like to congratulate two Plateau Club juniors for winning the state WJGA championship. Way to go Nathan Yocam and Ira Upadhyay! Nathan Yocam of Sammamish shot a final round 1-under par 71 at Semiahmoo G&CC to win the Boys' overall WJGA State Championship. Yocam eagled his final hole of the day by holing out a bunker shot to get to a 4-under par total for 54-holes. He then survived a 4-player playoff, capturing the title with a 12-foot par putt on the 4th playoff hole over Alexander Cooke of Spokane. Yocam is a 17-year-old entering his senior year at Eastlake High School.

Ira Upadhyay won the WJGA state championship (8-11 years girls). She was 2 over par for three days with scores of 72, 74, and 72, and won by 26 strokes. Her score of 2 over par would have finished 2nd in the girls 12-13 division.

KEEPER OF THE GREENS

It has been a hot and dry summer. Although we have not had the 100-degree days that we had last summer, we have had a hotter July and August in 2022 than we did in 2021. At the time that I am writing this, we have had 15 days break 90 degrees compared to 10 days in 2021.

September is here and that means aerification is right around the corner. We are planning on aerifying the greens during the week of September 19. Some benefits of aerifying the turf include relieving compaction, removing thatch, improving oxygen exchange in the soil, improving root growth, and improving water percolation.

Lastly, I hope everyone who played in the PMGA Member Guest and PWGA Ladies Invite enjoyed the course and had fun. Our crew had a good time preparing the course for the two events. Enjoy the rest of the summer and golfing season.

1st Match: 8:30am

2 Man Net Better Ball

All players will play their own ball and the team will score with the best net score vs. their opponent's best net score on each hole. Handicap strokes will be off the low player in the group.

2nd Match: 12:00pm

2 Man Net Alternate Shot

The team will select who tees off on the first hole and will play alternate shot through the hole. If you choose player A to tee off on the first hole, player B needs to hit the tee shot on the second hole, then alternate tee shots throughout the match. Your net score vs. your opponent's net score on each hole. Handicap strokes will be off the low team.
