NOTES FROM JASON

The rain looks like it has finally come, and it couldn't have been better timed with the wildfires creating less-than-desirable air quality for our area. Related to the fires, I thought the membership would be happy to read that the Snoqualmie Fire Fighters Association approached us about donating meals to the men and women protecting us from the fires. Chef Thomas and his team prepared 70 meals and delivered them on October 20. They were incredibly grateful for the Club's generosity.

In his announcement of my arrival, David Uchida let the membership know that I would send a letter after my first 30 days regarding my vision for moving forward. I have completed the 30 days and I hope you have had the chance to read the letter I sent out on November 1. I thought I'd touch upon a few items that have been completed or are in progress in this newsletter as well.

Our tennis courts have been repaired, restriped, repainted, and now include the ability to host pickleball on each court. One steam room in the Rec Center is now up and running, and the second is currently in progress for replacement. We now have yoga classes available as well.

We released a new, more expansive menu for the dining rooms. On October 21, we re-introduced Happy Hour at the Plateau Club, including \$6 draft beers, \$2 off wines by the glass, \$2 off cocktails, and \$2 off appetizers, including our popular chicken wings with four flavor options. Members can enjoy Happy Hour on Wed-Fri from 4-6pm. A new and extended wine list was also released on October 21. Additionally, you may have noticed some new staff in the clubhouse. We have started a new training program for them and seasoned staff, to increase the level of service the membership deserves.

Turf is purchasing new sprinkler heads for the golf course to provide greater coverage, which will help mitigate dry areas during the summer months. We are currently cleaning and repairing our course water stations, and they will return to the course in the spring. You likely saw tractors on the course a couple weeks ago as well; they are cleaning up our ponds on the course and fulfilling our obligation to the city and county as well as opening up some of the ponds for a nice visual esthetic. I personally enjoy coming into the club and seeing the 17th green.

The locker rooms are in the process of repair from the deck leak and some touch up paint in both. However, the deck leak remains an issue, and we have had contractors looking at the problem for a resolution. More on that matter as information comes my way.

It's been a wonderful first month getting to know the membership, staff, and our club. The Plateau Club is truly a special place, and I'm excited about the progress we will make in the future.

KEEPER OF THE GREENS

It was an abnormally dry and warm October, with an average high temperature of 76 degrees for the first 17 days of the month. The average high for those same days last October was 58 degrees. We also didn't have any measurable rain since September 4. With this combination of warmer temps and no rain, the turf didn't slow down on growing as it usually does this time of year.

During the next few weeks, we will go over our goals for the winter and set a timeline for completing them. We will also continue to work on our storm drain and retention ponds. Alder removal will happen again this winter to meet our requirements for King County & City of Sammamish. As many of you have noticed, we hired a company to cut the brush and trees around the retention pond. Having this work done "out of house" will free up a lot of our time to focus on the golf course this winter.

2 PERSON ALTERNATE SHOT

Sunday, November 6 • Tee Times

Format: 2 Person Select Drive Alternate Shot. Both players will hit from the tee and the team will select the best shot. The team will then play alternate shot until the ball is holed. If your tee shot is selected, your partner will hit the second shot. The team must use 7 tee shots per player.

Tees: Men will play from the blue tees, and women will play from the red tees.

Handicaps: Teams will receive 40% of their combined 18 hole handicaps.

Entry Fee: \$15/player. Prizes will be awarded for both gross and net winners.

Winter Rules: Shots must be played within one club length of the original lie no closer to the hole and the lie must remain similar (a ball in the rough must remain in the rough).

Format: Individual Play. The format will be a modified points system. The points are as follows:

Net Eagle	Touchdown	6 Points
Net Birdie	Field Goal	3 Points
Net Par	Safety	2 Points
Net Bogey	Extra Point	1 Point

Winter Rules: Lift, clean, and place. You may mark, lift, clean, and place your ball within one club length of your original lie no closer to the hole. A ball in the hazard must be played as it lies.
