KEEPER OF THE GREENS

Winter golf is here, and we find ourselves layering up to play a round of golf. The turfgrass also prepares itself for winter by layering up and storing nutrients. One of the key nutrients that our greens need during the winter is potassium. We apply potassium by foliar, which the plant can quickly absorb to help with winter stress and resistance to disease. Potassium also enhances root growth and wear tolerances; this keeps our greens in good shape for our members that play winter rounds. We supply the plant with Iron to help with the color of the greens; this fertility program keeps the rich green color and good health all winter long.

We have seen a lot of snow and wind recently. We have been busy picking up branches and blowing the golf course off between the snow and windstorms. We continue to work on clearing alders and tree pruning around the course. We have also had time to clear most of the forced carries of unwanted vegetation. Additionally, the turf department has raised irrigation heads to improve the irrigation uniformity and distribution for each head.

I am pleased with what the crew has been able to accomplish so far, and we will continue to improve the course throughout the rest of the winter. Happy New Year, I look forward to what 2023 brings us.

INDIVIDUAL PICK YOUR TEES

Saturday, January 14 • \$15 Entry Fee

Format: Pick Your Tees

Men will play six red tees, six blue tees, and six black tees. Women will play six short tees, six red tees, and six blue tees. It is up to you to decide which holes to play from which tee.

Handicap: 100%

2-PERSON BEST BALL

Saturday, January 22

Format: 2-Person Best Ball

Teams will be made up of two people. Each player will play their own ball until it is holed. The team will score with the best score of the two players on each hole.

Winter Rules: Shots must be played within one club-length of the original lie, no closer to the hole, and the lie must remain similar (a ball in the rough remains in the rough).

Tees: Blue & Red

Men will play from the blue tees and women will play from the red tees.

Handicaps: 100%

The team will receive 100% of their course handicap.

Entry Fee: \$15 per player

There will be prizes awarded for both gross and net winners.

SUPER BOWL GOLF

Sunday, February 5

Format: Individual play. Super Bowl Golf will be an individual net game. The format will be a modified points system. The points are as follows:

Net Eagle	Touchdown	6 points
Net Birdie	Field Goal	3 points
Net Par	Safety	2 points
Net Bogey	Extra Point	1 point

Flights: Two flights (AFC & NFC)

Flights will be determined by handicap index. The low half of the field will be in the AFC flight, and the high half will be in the NFC.

Tees: Men will play from the blue tees and women will play from the red tees.

Winter Rules: Lift, clean, and place.

You may mark, lift, clean, and place your ball within one club length of your original lie, no closer to the hole. A ball in the hazard must be played as it lies.

Entry Fee: \$15 per person.
