KEEPER OF THE GREENS

The winter months are almost over, and spring is just around the corner. With it being March, greens aerification is a few weeks away. We are planning to aerify the greens on March 27 & 28. These dates depend on the weather, as we will need two days of dry weather to complete the aerification process. Tee aerification is planned for the middle of March, and fairway aerification will begin at the beginning of March, as we plan to have 1-2 fairways aerified a day until they are completed.

February was a busy month for the turf department. We finished clearing all of the forced carries on the golf course and worked on cutting down alders and cottonwood trees along parts of the cart path. We chipped most of those trees and spread the chips on the walking paths. The crew spent about a week focusing on weeding and raking out the landscape beds with a plan to add new mulch in the next month. We have also made irrigation upgrades to the first fairway by replacing some of the irrigation heads on the second half of the hole.
