# GOLF DEPARTMENT UPDATES

We have transitioned from our summer weather into our typical fall weather, and with that comes some restrictions and reminders about the golf course. With the amount of rain we typically get, the golf cart policy will be Cart Path Only unless notified by the golf shop staff on the day of play. We have handicap flags for members who have an approved medical exemption, and we ask that the player come and grab a handicap flag from the golf shop and attach it to the golf cart. There may be days when the course is over-saturated, and we will not be able to allow handicap flag access for the golf carts. The turf department will make this decision, and we will update the online tee sheet so you can see if handicap flag access is not allowed that day.

With the wet ground conditions, the divots being produced will become larger than what is typically seen during the summer months. Please be aware of this and replace those larger divots so we can maintain the course in the best winter conditions possible for play.

We will be hosting Winter Golf Shop Tournaments throughout the off-season. These events are open to all members and their guests (with a GHIN handicap). Be on the lookout for communication regarding dates and formats soon.

# DRESS CODE

## GOLF COURSE

### **Acceptable attire for men and male children 5 and older:**

- Collared shirts with sleeves or golf course appropriate mock neck shirts, jackets & pullovers
- Golf appropriate slacks. Golf appropriate shorts no shorter than 4" above the knee
- Golf appropriate rain gear

### **Acceptable attire for women and female children 5 years and older:**

- Sleeved and sleeveless tops with collars or golf course appropriate mock neck shirts, pullovers, and jackets
- Golf appropriate dresses, skirts, and shorts no shorter than 4" above the knee
- Golf appropriate slacks
- Golf appropriate rain gear

**NOT acceptable attire for all members, guests, and children:** No sweatpants, tracksuits, workout attire, tank tops, bathing suits, athletic shorts or shirts, tee shirts, or hats worn backwards.

## CLUBHOUSE\*

### **Acceptable attire for men, women, and children 5 and older:**

- Collared shirts with sleeves or golf course appropriate mock neck shirts, jackets & pullovers
- Golf appropriate slacks. Golf appropriate shorts no shorter than 4" above the knee
- (Women) Sleeved and sleeveless tops with collars or golf course appropriate mock neck shirts, pullovers, and jackets
- (Women) Golf dresses, skirts, and shorts no shorter than 4" above the knee.
- Denim pants are free of rips and/or tears

**NOT acceptable attire for all members, guests, and children:** No sweatpants, tracksuits, workout attire, tank tops, bathing suits, athletic shorts or shirts, tee shirts, or hats worn backwards.

\*some club events may have specific attire guidelines. Members will be informed of these as they occur.

## FITNESS FACILITY

Appropriate workout attire is acceptable in the fitness facility. Shoes must be worn at all times.

## SWIMMING POOL

Swim attire is strictly limited to the pool deck and locker rooms.

## RECREATION CENTER CLUBHOUSE

All clubhouse, fitness facility, and golf course attire are acceptable in the Recreation Center Clubhouse. Shoes must be worn at all times.

## TENNIS/PICKLEBALL

Appropriate tennis attire must be worn at all times.

Appropriate tennis shoes. NO dress or other style shoes that may leave marks on the courts are allowed.

NO jeans are allowed on the courts.

# KEEPER OF THE GREENS

October was a busy month for the turf department. We have already been able to raise about 35 irrigation heads that were low to the surface of the turf. Raising the irrigation heads will improve the way they perform next year by not having the water distribution blocked by the turf. This will help the water get to the full extent of the intended range while the head is running and lessen the possibility of dry spots in the fairways and rough. We will continue this project through the rest of the winter. We also sodded the hydraulic leaks on number 1 and 8 greens. We have also been able to keep up with regular mowing maintenance through October.

During the next few weeks, we will be going over our goals for the winter and setting a timeline for the completion of these goals. We will continue to work on our storm drain and retention ponds with alder removal again this winter to meet our requirements for King County & City of Sammamish.
